

Professor Enzo Durante is professor of General Surgery at the University of Ferrara, Italy, School of Medicine and head of the General Surgery Unit and coordinator of the breast multidisciplinary team. Professor Durante started his research into ultrasonic imaging in 1973 and co-founded the first Italian Society of Ultrasound in Medicine & Biology in 1974. In the same year, he started performing ultrasound guided interventional procedures. Major fields of research have been breast diagnosis and breast surgery; performing surgery from many years using a personal technique under ultrasound guidance achieving excellent cosmetic results and the lowest rate of recurrences in the literature, that is less than 1%.

Professor Durante has published 223 papers in professional journals; nine book chapters and he is the author or editor of nine books. Professor Durante has been an invited speaker at 106 congresses, and a lecturer in 106 postgraduate courses or seminars. He is the chairman of the scientific committee for the International Breast Ultrasound Course held in Ferrara, Italy every year. Professor Durante is a founding member of the International Breast Ultrasound School (IBUS), and is currently the secretary of IBUS.
